Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that the Government has launched an e-market portal "e-pashudhan Haat" for bovine germplasm for connecting breeders and farmers of indigenous bovine breeds;
- b) if so, the benefits of the said scheme to the farmers; and
- c) the details of the progress report on E-Pashudhan Haat at present?

(a to (c) Yes, Madam. Government has launched e-Pashu Haat portal (www.epashuhaat.gov.in) for connecting breeders and farmers of indigenous breeds. Through the portal farmers can obtain information on location of quality indigenous germplasm in the form live animals, semen doses and embryos. This portal is playing crucial role in development and conservation of indigenous breeds. As on date complete information along with pedigree and productivity details on availability of 40,542 live animals, 6.25 crore semen doses and 372 embryos is available on the portal (as on 28.12.2017).
